Thank you, family! God must be proud of all of you.

Once again the care-a-thon will be filled with fun times as there will be a different guest each hour and a new trivia question every 30 min. Prizes will be given throughout the day. In addition to being live on the air, DMR will be live on Facebook, YouTube, and hopefully Rumble. To stream on Rumble free of charge, DMR's account needs 100 followers. Please consider creating a Rumble account, search for Divine Mercy Radio, then click "follow" the station and "like" the posted video.

What we like about Rumble is that when a person creates an account, only people they want to follow will enter their feed, thus preventing unwanted solicitation and information.
